



## Miller's Run School Informational Meeting 6:00 pm, Tuesday, February 27, 2018

Beginning July 1, 2018 Miller's Run School District will become part of the new Kingdom East School District. This year we will be voting on a budget for the new Kingdom East District instead of voting on a Miller's Run budget. The vote will take place in April, not on Town Meeting day. There are a number of Articles to be voted on by Australian Ballot this year. This flyer explains some of the ballot measures. Please join us at the meeting next Tuesday at Miller's Run school for further explanation.

On the Miller's Run School District Warning, Articles seven (7) through eleven (11) address how to manage the reserve funds that belong to the Miller's Run School District. Currently there are several reserve funds that will sunset on June 30 of this year. The Board felt that the citizens of Sheffield and Wheelock would want to keep the reserve funds for Miller's Run School.

**Article 7** asks the voters to open a Facilities Fund with money that already exists in Miller's Run current account. This fund is set up so Miller's Run can address physical plant needs in future years.

**Article 8** asks the voters to open a Performing Arts Fund. The board felt the community valued and wanted to assure the continuity of the performing arts program. Currently we have violin and musical training this spring. This fund would be set up for the performing arts program.

**Article 9** asks the voters to place the money in the current capital reserve account into the new fund created under Article 7. To assure this money continues to be available solely to Miller's Run, this Article asks voters to transfer the money into the new account.

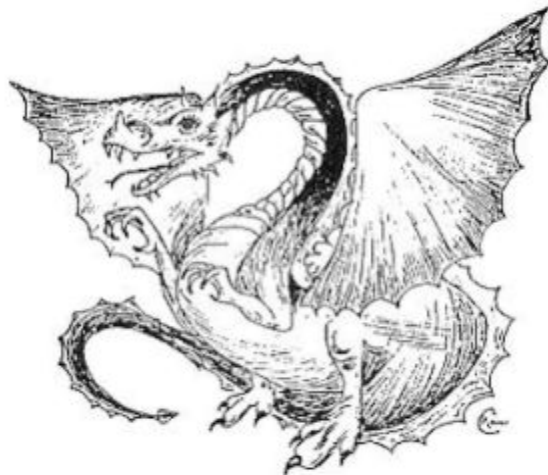
**Article 10** asks the voters to assure current funds continue to be available solely for Miller's Run, and to transfer the funds in the current Equipment Reserve account into the new Educational Facility Reserve account.

**Article 11** Because Miller's Run, Sheffield and Wheelock will share the same tax rate as all other towns in Kingdom East, any Tax Stabilization money after July 1, 2018 would be used to stabilize taxes for all towns. This article asks the voters to move money from a tax stabilization fund into the Performing Arts Fund. By asking the voters to Transfer money to the Performing Arts Fund this will provide Arts for the students attending Miller's Run.

**Article 12** allows any surplus funds from this year to be applied to the Performing Arts Fund.
